Rodents are voracious predators of invertebrates. The loss of invertebrates is particularly significant because invertebrates play an important role in maintaining natural ecological functions.

This month we will celebrate the discovery and revival of the rare Phasmid and the wider context of invertebrate conservation on Lord Howe Island and across the globe.

Our seabirds and oceans are being impacted by plastic and marine debris. Help survey the diverse intertidal ecosystem of Lord Howe Island Marine Park and provide valuable data for ongoing research. Undertake beach surveys to collect beach debris, sort and identify different plastic types as an aid to promoting solutions.
